When a birthday falls on Merdeka Day , the opportunity for celebration is even greater . The celebratory spirit can make the day feel even more special .

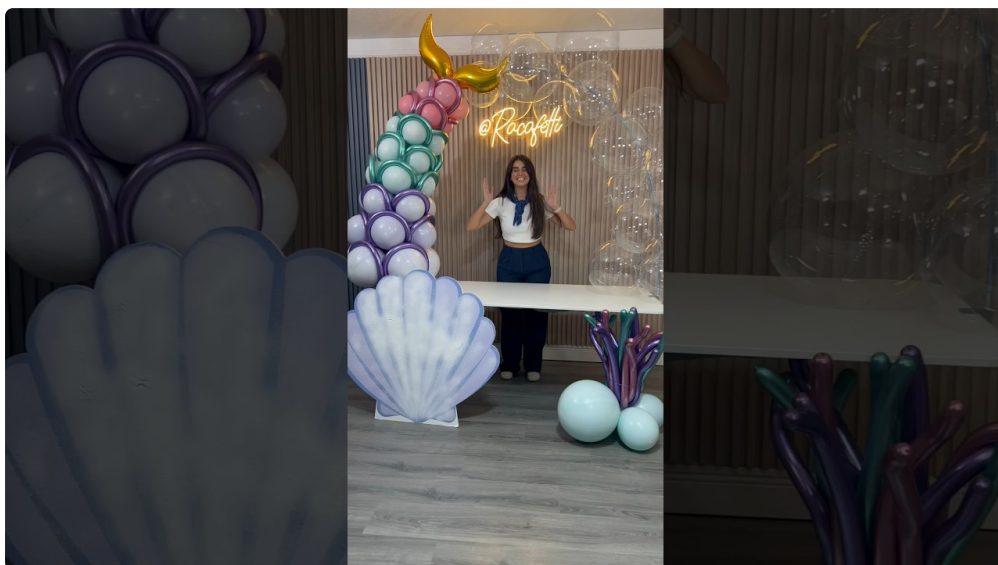


You can incorporate patriotic themes into the party. Consider blue and white decorations , and do something themed around the country.
