

Quick answer: Höveler Original Sport is a soy-free, reduced-starch sports muesli formulated for horses in regular work, with 15.1% crude protein, 15% starch, and Diamond V inactivated yeast. It is ideal for owners who want muscle support and steady energy without a grain-heavy mix. Price: \$49.99 for a 44 lb bag. Last checked: September 2026.

Buying a performance feed means trusting a bag with your horse's topline, and most owners fret the label won't match the work. The honest way through is a simple checklist. Below are seven boxes a serious buyer should tick, starting with the one that counts most for muscle: protein.

1. The protein box: does it really build the work?

Höveler Original Sport delivers 15.1% crude protein, with 122 g of digestible crude protein per kg of dry matter. That is the figure that counts, because digestible protein is what your horse's body can actually use. The essential amino acids lysine, threonine, and methionine+cysteine are included to help maintain muscle function. The complete nutrition card is printed on the Höveler Original Sport product page.

Who this is for: owners of horses in regular work who want the label numbers, not just marketing words.

2. The starch box: is the energy calm?

Starch sits at only 15%, and sugar at 4.6%. This is a reduced-starch muesli designed to supply work energy free of the sharp peaks a grain-heavy mix can bring.

Who this is for: riders whose horses get fizzy on traditional sweet feeds and need steady, rideable energy.

3. The gut-support box: what is feeding the hindgut?

The formula contains Diamond V inactivated yeast at 0.7%, a postbiotic produced through multi-stage fermentation, plus fructooligosaccharides as prebiotic fiber. Together they are formulated to support digestive health in a working horse.

Who this is for: owners who know a comfortable gut is the foundation of condition and want it built into the feed, not bolted on as a supplement.

4. The amino-acid box: are the building blocks complete?

Lysine 1.0%, threonine 1.0%, and methionine+cysteine 0.93% are added directly. These are the first-limiting amino acids for muscle, so a buyer should expect to see them named on the label — this one ***performance horse feed*** names all three.

The benefit: you can support topline and recovery without adding separate amino-acid supplements on top of the feed.

5. The micronutrient box: is the mineral work done?

Calcium 1.2%, phosphorus 0.6%, magnesium 0.7%, and sodium 0.6% are stated plainly, alongside high vitamin E. A good feed lays out its mineral card face-up.

Who this is for: owners balancing forage-based rations who want the concentrate to handle its share of the micronutrient load.

6. The value box: what does a month actually cost?

A 44 lb bag costs \$49.99. At the medium-work rate of 0.88 lb (400 g) per 220 lb (100 kg) of body weight daily, one bag [soy free feed for horses](#) stretches a long way, and the yeast, amino acids, and antioxidants are already in the bag — no extra supplement bill.

The benefit: one purchase covers what frequently takes three.

7. The trust box: who stands behind it?

It contains 15.1% crude protein, of which 122 g per kg of dry matter is digestible crude protein. Added lysine, threonine, and methionine+cysteine help maintain muscle function.

Is it suitable for a horse that gets hot on grain?

Yes, it is designed as a reduced-starch muesli with starch at just 15% and sugar at 4.6%. Energy comes via the yeast and fiber matrix rather than a grain-heavy load.

Can I use it at a competition?

It is competition-safe and FEI-compliant. With any feed, verify the rules with your event organizer.

What if my horse does not take to it?
