Popular Aviator Strategies and Tactics

- **The Low-Risk/ Conservative Strategy:**

- *How it works:* Players established Auto Cash Out at low multipliers, such as 1.20 x to 1.50 x, and location smaller bets.
- *Goal:* To accomplish regular, little wins that gradually construct the bankroll. The drawback is that a single unexpected 1.00 x crash (where the airplane flies away right away) can erase a number of previous gains.

- **The Dual-Bet Strategy:**

- *How it works:* Players put 2 bets simultaneously. The very first bet is set to auto-cash out at a moderate multiplier (e.g., 2.00 x) to secure a revenue or break even. The 2nd bet is left to run by hand for a greater, riskier multiplier (e.g., 10x or greater).
- *Objective:* Balancing security with the thrill of chasing an enormous payout.

- **The Martingale System (Use with Caution):**
