

Encino or Sherman Oaks at a Glance

Encino and Sherman Oaks are adjacent communities in the San Fernando Valley, within Los Angeles. Garage Door Spring Service Near Me

A **torsion spring** is mounted above the garage door and uses regulated rotational force to balance the door. An **extension spring** is installed along the horizontal tracks and stretches as the door moves. The correct spring depends on the door’s weight, height, track configuration, and existing hardware.

Professional garage door spring replacement should include a spring safety inspection, cable inspection, bearing or roller review, balance test, and opener assessment. Replacing only one spring on a system with two matched springs may not be appropriate if the second spring is also nearing replacement.

Overall door weight and garage door size affect the counterbalance system and opener choice. Installing a replacement for a door without evaluating the header, mounting points, tracks, and electrical access can result in additional costs. Garage Door Opener Installation Cost
