For homes with pets, ask about odor treatment rather than assuming ordinary cleaning will solve it. Pet-related issues often need targeted work, especially if the accident was not addressed right away. A quick surface clean can improve the look, but odor can linger in padding and subfloor areas. That is the kind of detail worth discussing before anyone begins.

What to look for in the service conversation
