

A cracked windshield has a way of turning an ordinary drive into a small expedition. One minute you are rolling through Greensboro with the radio low and the road clear. The next, a stone pops off a truck tire, snaps against the glass, and leaves a starburst right in your line of sight. It is a tiny event, but it changes the whole mood of the trip.
