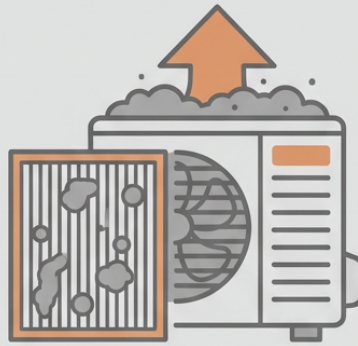

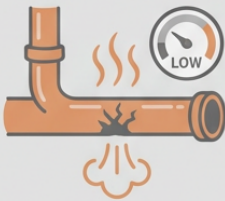
What are common AC problems?

Dirty filters and coils lead to reduced efficiency, system strain, and eventual breakdown.

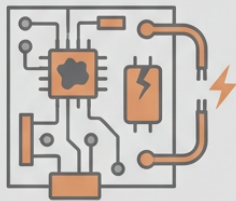


Refrigerant Leaks
