 - Factory New (0.00-- 0.07)
 - Minimal Wear (0.07-- 0.15)
 - Field-Tested (0.15-- 0.38)
 - Well-Worn (0.38-- 0.45)
 - Battle-Scarred (0.45-- 1.00)
2. **Pattern Index:** Some skins include patterns that shift across the weapon mesh. Specific uncommon pattern templates (like Blue Gems on Case Hardened skins) can increase a weapon's base value tremendously.
