Red dust trips in on shoes and paw pads, desert air dries out fibers, and kids in some way grind Goldfish crumbs into places no vacuum can reach. St George homes ask a lot of their floors. That's what you want: process discipline, not luck.

4. Heat, vacuum, and pressure balanced for our climate

You can hear an effective truckmount from the driveway, but raw power isn't enough. Carpet cleaners need to stabilize three variables: heat, water pressure, and vacuum. Excessive heat can set certain dyes or impact protectants. Spraying a deodorizer on the surface area won't repair it.

The best method depends upon intensity. For light mishaps, an enzymatic pre-spray and comprehensive rinse might do it. For repeated areas in the very same area, I search for companies that can perform subsurface extraction. This involves saturating the area with a solution created to break down salts and germs, then drawing out from below the backing with a specialized tool that pulls liquid from the pad. It's not glamorous, however it's effective. For severe cases, the only truthful solution is to pull the carpet, change the afflicted pad, seal the subfloor, and re-install. 6. Respect for your home: protection, containment, and cleanup

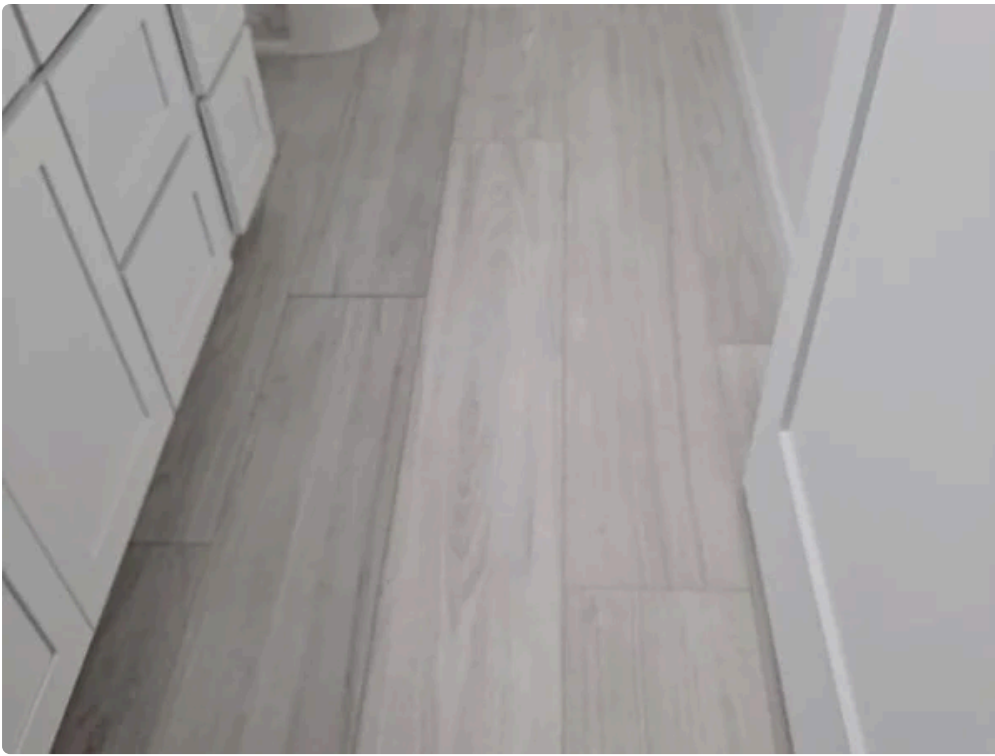
