Why Are Case Battles So Popular?

In a 4-player Free-For-All, your mathematical opportunity of winning drops to 25%. In a [Additional resources](#) 1v1 head-to-head battle, your odds instantly leap to 50%. If consistency is the goal, adhering to two-player rooms is generally smarter.

3. Diversify Your Case Selection

Avoid discarding your entire budget plan into a single high-tier case like *Operation Bravo* or *Recoil*. Rather, mix low-tier, stable-return cases with a couple of high-variance cases to balance the threat.

4. Use "Crazy Mode" Cautiously

Crazy Mode (where the least expensive overall value wins) turns basic logic on its head. While it can be fun, it relies totally on hitting low-cost, low-tier drops. Do not approach this mode with standard case-opening logic.
