

Opioids took hold of Los Angeles County the same way they took hold of the rest of the country, through prescription painkillers, then heroin, then fentanyl, and the response has to be as serious as the problem itself. Alpha Recovery Center in Lancaster, California, treats opioid addiction across that whole range, from prescription painkillers to heroin to fentanyl, starting with inpatient medical detox so a client is medically supervised through the physical part of withdrawal. Medication assisted treatment is available at Alpha Recovery Center to support clients through cravings in early recovery, used alongside individual therapy, group therapy, family therapy, and cognitive behavioral therapy to address the behaviors and thought patterns that kept opioid use going. Dual diagnosis treatment covers clients whose opioid use developed alongside chronic pain, untreated trauma, anxiety, or depression, since treating the substance use in isolation rarely produces lasting change. As a client stabilizes, the program moves from detox into residential treatment, a partial hospitalization program, an intensive outpatient program, or an outpatient program, matching the level of structure to where that person actually is. The Antelope Valley location near Edwards Air Force Base and Air Force Plant 42 means the program sees a fair number of veterans and aerospace workers managing opioid dependence that often started with a legitimate prescription for pain, and staff are experienced with that particular path into addiction. Bryan, the on-site therapist, is named repeatedly in reviews as central to client progress, and Tony, the owner, is known for being present at the facility rather than working from a distance. Clients also mention staff members Chelsea, Annie, Heidi, and Jessica as part of a team that treats people with respect rather than judgment.
