4. Major Tournaments and View Passes

Throughout Valve-sponsored CS2 Major champions, audiences can buy or in some cases make Souvenir Packages.



- By viewing the tournament live through the Steam TV or in-game client, or by taking part in the Pick 'Em Challenge using a Viewer Pass, gamers can earn Souvenir Cases specific to that competition.
- These cases do not require a crucial to open, making them 100% complimentary value as soon as acquired.

Alternative Methods: External Sites (Proceed with Caution)

Many third-party sites promote "totally free CS: GO cases" through sign-up bonus offers, promotion codes, or everyday benefits. While **read more** a few of these platforms are genuine community-trusted trading or betting websites, players must work out extreme care.
