Understanding the Top Slot and Multipliers

Before every spin of the main wheel, a smaller sized two-reel slots located directly above the wheel-- called the **Top Slot**-- spins all at once.

- **How it works:** The Top Slot generates one random wheel sector (a number or a reward video game) and sets it with a random multiplier ranging from 2x to 50x.
- **The Result:** If the primary wheel lands on the specific sector revealed in the Top Slot, the multiplier is applied to that spin. If it is a number bet, the payment is multiplied. If it is a bonus offer game, the multipliers within the perk round are increased accordingly.

The Four Crazy Time Bonus Rounds

The main tourist attraction of the game is its 4 bonus offer rounds. Gamers who have actually positioned a wager on the particular perk sector are approved entry into the mini-game when the wheel lands on it.

1. Coin Flip

- **Frequency:** 4 sections on the wheel.

2. Cash Hunt

- **Frequency:** 2 sections on the wheel.

3. Pachinko

- **Frequency:** 2 segments on the wheel.
- **Gameplay:** A radiant puck is dropped from the top of a massive Pachinko wall filled with pegs. The puck bounces down randomly up until it lands in among the slots at the bottom, each consisting of a multiplier. If the puck arrive on a "DOUBLE," all multipliers on the board double, and the puck is dropped once again.

4. Crazy Time

- **Frequency:** Only 1 segment on the wheel.
- **Gameplay:** Players step behind a red door into a dynamic, surreal virtual world featuring an enormous 64-segment wheel. The host picks one of three flappers (Green, Blue, or Yellow). The wheel spins, and whatever multiplier the picked flapper indicate is granted. Like Pachinko, this wheel includes "DOUBLE" and "TRIPLE" segments, allowing multipliers to reach up to a shocking 20,000 x.

Essential Tips for Betting on Crazy Time

Since Crazy Time is a game of pure opportunity governed by a Random Number Generator (RNG) and physical physics, no technique can guarantee a win. However, players can manage their bankrolls and optimize their gameplay by adhering to certain best practices.



- **Diversify Your Bets:** Placing little wagers throughout several numbers and benefit rounds ensures that you remain in the action longer and do not miss out when a benefit round hits.
- **Focus On the Bonus Rounds:** Statistically, the home edge on the number sectors (1, 2, 5, 10) is usually higher than the benefit rounds. Numerous seasoned players select to put little bets specifically on the 4 perk segments to go after the video game's maximum payout capacity.
- **Set a Strict Budget:** The hectic nature of live game programs can cause fast costs. Select a fixed bankroll before you begin playing and adhere to it, no matter wins or losses.

- **Do Not Chase Losses:** If you experience a cold streak where the wheel bypasses your bets, prevent the temptation to increase your stake sizes to recover lost funds rapidly.
