

How Burbank Weather Impacts Garage Doors

Burbank, California sits in the San Fernando Valley, where the Los Angeles climate brings dry, high-temperature summers, intense sunshine, temperature swings, and mild winters with seasonal rainfall. These conditions are generally pleasant for homeowners, but they can gradually influence an overhead garage door, its mechanical parts, and its powered operating mechanism.

Winter Rain, Moisture, and Corrosion Risks
