3. Case Opening and Battles

Valve's official video game cases require costly keys to open, with notoriously low chances of receiving uncommon items. CSGO betting sites capitalized on this by offering custom-made case openings with adjusted odds. *Case Battles* take this an action even more, allowing several players to open the exact same cases at the same time, with the player who unpacks the greatest overall value winning all the contents.

4. Coinflip

A classic 1v1 video game of chance. 2 gamers wager skins of roughly equivalent value. The system designates one player as Heads and the other as Tails, then turns a virtual coin. The winner takes the whole pot, minus a small platform commission (rake).

5. Esports Match Betting

For fans of the professional scene (BLAST Premier, ESL Pro League, Majors), match wagering is the go-to choice. Users wager on expert teams using odds calculated by the platform, comparable to conventional sportsbooks.

Comparing CSGO Gambling Formats
