- Verify headroom, sideroom, and backroom clearances versus the submittal drawings, not just the brochure.
- Identify power and smoke alarm terminations, including voltage, get in touch with type, and required supervision.
- Decide on egress technique and signage if the opening remains in a path of travel, so people do not count on a door that will shut on alarm.
- Lock in finishes and rust security based upon the environment, such as galvanized or stainless for seaside garages.

How a tidy installment in fact unfolds on site

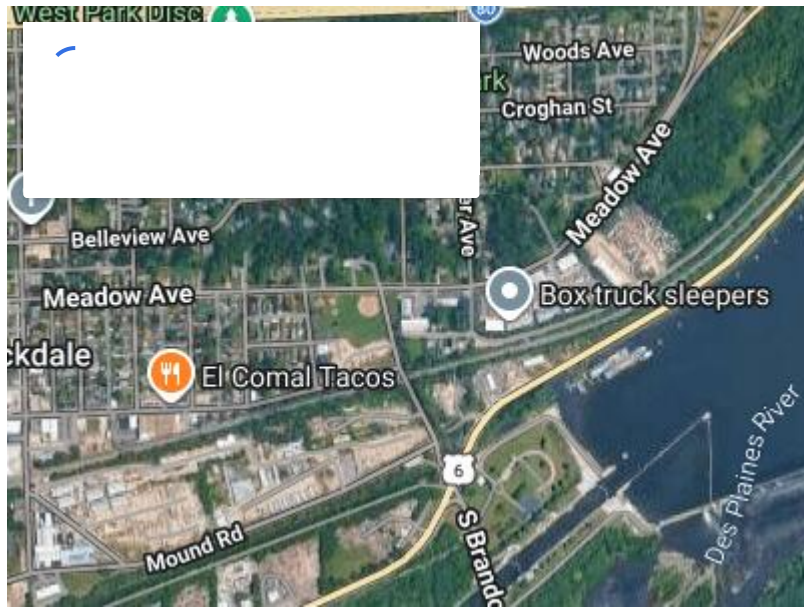
