

What Is Garage Door Alignment Repair?

Garage door alignment repair fixes the placement and travel of an overhead garage door so it travels evenly through the garage door tracks. The tracks guide the door's rollers as the panels travel up and down. If the tracks, rollers, hinges, panels, or lifting system are improperly positioned, the door may rub, bind, tilt, or stop before reaching the floor.

Proper garage door alignment is essential for safe operation and even weight distribution. A small adjustment may involve tightening hardware, repositioning a track, or lubricating or replacing damaged garage door rollers. More complex problems may involve a bent garage door track, a damaged garage door panel, or a malfunctioning spring system.

- **Sticking garage door:** The door catches, stops, or becomes difficult to lift manually.
- **Rattling garage door:** Grinding, or repeated squealing can indicate damaged rollers, loose hardware, or track contact.
- **Noticeable track gaps:** The rollers may appear partly outside the tracks, or the tracks may no longer sit parallel.
- **Irregular movement:** The door shakes, tilts, or reverses while opening or closing.
- **Safety sensor problems:** Misalignment, vibration, or a crooked door can cause the garage door safety sensors to interrupt closing.
- **Panel pulling apart:** Sections may bend or pull apart as the door moves.

If the door closes partway and then reverses, check whether the safety sensor lights are steady and whether anything interferes with the opening. However, sensor symptoms can also result from a door that is binding or sitting unevenly. Continued operation may aggravate the original fault.

Common Sources of Garage Door Alignment Problems

A **deformed garage door track** is a common cause of alignment issues. A car collision, falling debris, or force from a door that was operated by hand while obstructed can bend the vertical or horizontal section. Even a small distortion can prevent the garage door rollers from moving properly.
