- **Fracture Case:** Offers a diverse knife swimming pool with shattered-web design knives and functions stunning concealed skins like the M4A4|Cyber Security.

For players who wish to experience the excitement of opening cases without breaking the bank, low-priced cases with high-tier capacity are the ideal option.

- **Buy Cases Directly:** If a specific skin is wanted, it is usually more affordable to acquire it directly from the Steam Community Market or a third-party marketplace rather than attempting to unbox it.
- **Think About Upgrading to CS2-Optimized Skins:** With the engine upgrade to Source 2, metallic surfaces, pearls, and dopplers look unbelievable. Cases that drop these surfaces have actually seen a rise in visual appeal.
