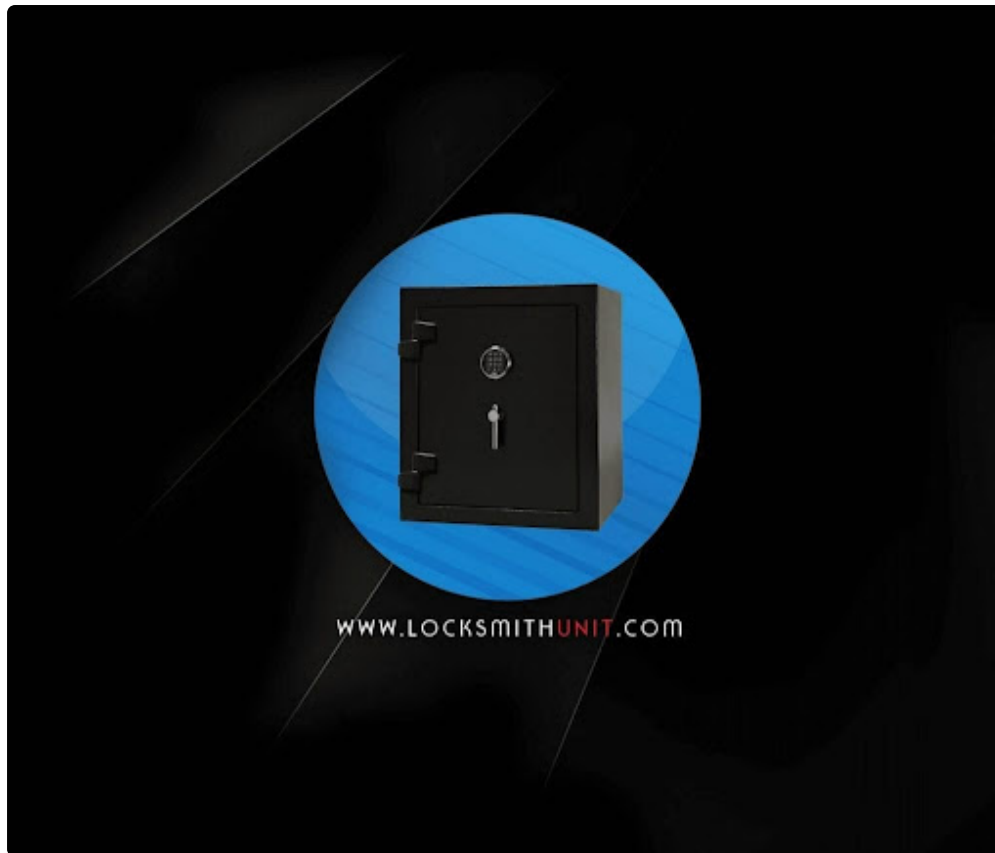
Deadbolts, smart locks, and the hardware that gets used every day
