

Lock repair and replacement in Orlando often starts with the same practical question, which is whether the hardware can still be trusted for daily use. What lock repair in Orlando usually covers

If the bolt does not line up with the strike, the lock may look broken even though the core issue is movement in the door frame.

A lock that has been forced, drilled, or corroded beyond reliable operation is usually better replaced than patched.
