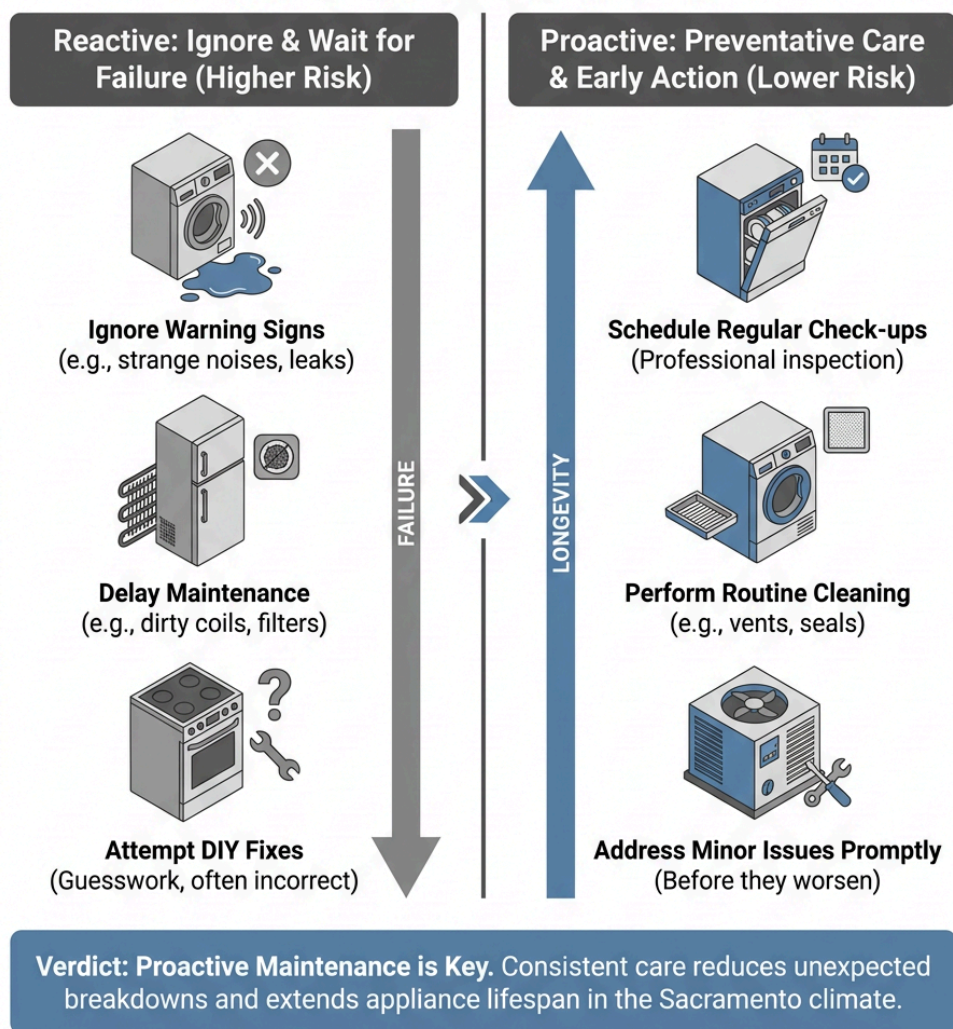

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## What lead-time metrics reveal about your refrigerator's actual repair window?
