

South Yarra is a beautiful place to live, but it comes with a very real downside: space is tight, bins fill up fast, and when you finally decide to clear out the mess, the items you uncover are never the light ones. It is always the couch that weighs more than you expected, the boxed-in wardrobe you cannot tilt without scraping the walls, the old TV stand wedged behind storage, or garden debris that somehow doubled in volume during the last few weekends.

If you have been trying to solve hard rubbish yourself, you probably already know the pattern. You start with good intentions, drag one heavy item outside, realise you need another person because your back is now part of the problem, then notice the stairs, the narrow driveway, the neighbours' bins, and the fact that what you thought would be "one trip" is actually several. ## **Common large items people need moved**
