For arches, a flexible tape designed for curves can help, however you continue to ought to seal the tape edge appropriate.

- Back-roll into corners lightly, then lay off with the aid of brushing far from the threshold to get rid of stipple
- Keep coats skinny at edges to evade ridging, two thin passes beat one heavy pass
- Pull tape at the same time the paint is simply past cheesy, not entirely dry, for a crisp launch
- If you nick an side, do not chase it wet, enable it dry, then straighten with a 1-inch contact-up brush

On cupboard cubbies or built-in bookshelves, eliminate adjustable cabinets and label every pin hole row in the past portray.
