

Lock repair and replacement in Orlando often starts with the same practical question, which is whether the hardware can still be trusted for daily use. Repair details that matter more than most people expect

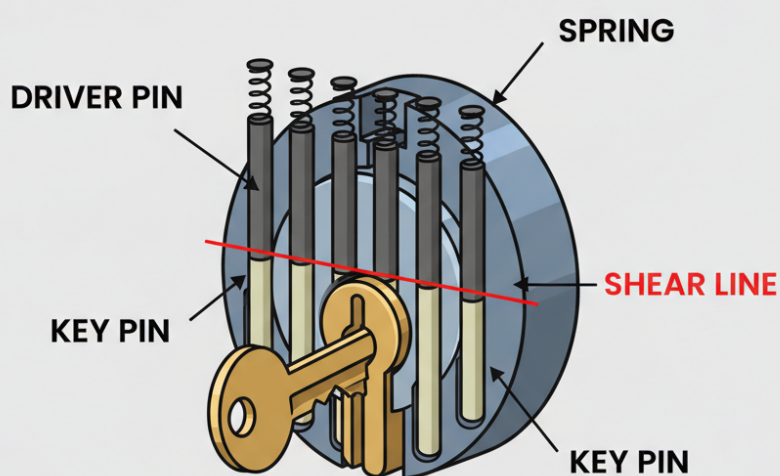
outside, and look for wear around the strike area. It can also show when a so-called lock issue is really a door sag or hinge problem.

If the fragment is removed cleanly and the core has not been damaged, the lock may still be perfectly usable after a new key is made or programmed.
