In a 4-player Free-For-All, your mathematical opportunity of winning drops to 25%. In a 1v1 head-to-head battle, your chances immediately leap to 50%. If consistency is the objective, adhering to two-player rooms is usually wiser.

3. Diversify Your Case Selection

Avoid disposing your whole budget plan into a single high-tier case like *Operation Bravo* or *Recoil*. Rather, mix low-tier, stable-return cases with a couple of high-variance cases to stabilize the threat.

4. Use "Crazy Mode" Cautiously

Crazy Mode (where the most affordable overall value wins) turns basic logic on its head. While it can be fun, it relies entirely on hitting inexpensive, low-tier drops. Do not approach this mode with basic case-opening logic.
