### 3. Case Opening and Battles

Valve presented weapon cases to CSGO, however third-party sites took the principle further. Users can open virtual cases with fixed odds. **Case Battles** take this a step further: two or more gamers buy into the same cases, open them at the same time, and whoever pulls the highest overall skin value wins all the products from both gamers.

### 4. Coinflip

A simple, high-stakes game of chance. Two players wager equivalent skin values, a virtual coin is flipped, and the winner takes the pot (minus a small home charge).

## Comparing CSGO Gambling Mechanics
