A clean, consistent wrap separates the pros from the relaxation. You can opt for an appropriate solution and rod measurement, then smash it with sloppy sectioning. I use brick-lay styles to diffuse element traces and keep stack marks. Even rigidity is essential. If the tension at the front isn't the same as the lower back, your curls will mirror that imbalance.

Endpaper approach things greater than most have an understanding of. Fishhooks aren't a thriller, they arrive from ends bending back on themselves.
