Old, flaking movie receives scraped to a corporation edge, then sanded to feather the transition. For naked picket, I sand to eighty or one hundred grit on flooring, moderately finer, a hundred and twenty to 150, on

On patios, I degrease with a citrus solvent wherein grills have dripped, then use a stress wash at nontoxic distance.
