Understanding the Top Slot and Multipliers

Before every spin of [crazy time games list](#) the main wheel, a smaller two-reel fruit machine located directly above the wheel-- called the **Top Slot**-- spins concurrently.

- **How it works:** The Top Slot produces one random wheel section (a number or a bonus game) and sets it with a random multiplier ranging from 2x to 50x.
- **The Result:** If the main wheel arrive at the exact sector revealed in the Top Slot, the multiplier is used to that spin. If it is a number bet, the payout is multiplied. If it is a reward video game, the multipliers within the benefit round are increased appropriately.

The Four Crazy Time Bonus Rounds

1. Coin Flip

4. Crazy Time

- **Frequency:** Only 1 section on the wheel.
- **Gameplay:** Players step behind a red door into a dynamic, surreal virtual world including a colossal 64-segment wheel. The host selects among 3 flappers (Green, Blue, or Yellow). The wheel spins, and whatever multiplier the picked flapper indicate is granted. Like Pachinko, this wheel includes "DOUBLE" and "TRIPLE" segments, allowing multipliers to reach up to a shocking 20,000 x.

- **Focus On the Bonus Rounds:** Statistically, the house edge on the number segments (1, 2, 5, 10) is normally higher than the reward rounds. Numerous experienced gamers pick to position little bets exclusively on the 4 benefit sections to chase the game's optimum payment capacity.
- **Set a Strict Budget:** The fast-paced nature of live video game programs can lead to fast spending. Choose a fixed bankroll before you begin playing and adhere to it, despite wins or losses.
