Build a setup ordinary, now not a pile of steps

Intent shows up via motion.

If your hands pause in a unusual means, hover too long, or move in a development that doesn't tournament your spoken clarification, the target audience notices. Even if they are not able to see what you might be doing, they sense a mismatch. The manner to fix that's to align your bodily moves with your verbal framing.

A practical method is to speak at the same time as you movement in a practical course, in place of communicating after which performing.
