A new Energy Star-rated refrigerator uses roughly 40 percent less electricity than a model from fifteen years ago. If your current appliance requires a costly repair—say a compressor replacement at \$600 to \$800—and the appliance is already nine years old, you face a genuine dilemma. Repair it now, and you are betting on two to three more years of declining efficiency. Replace it, and a modern unit pays for itself within five to seven years through lower utility bills alone.
