## **Field installation overview**

- Set the overviews true and plumb, shim where essential, and anchor per maker torque worths into the ranked wall surface assembly.
- Hoist the barrel and coil into area, balance the assembly, and engage bearings and braces without binding.
- Thread and tension the drape, set limits for normal operation if motorized, and set up hood and closing devices.
- Wire the fire launch control to the FACP per the riser layout, validate supervision, and carry out a functional examination from both neighborhood and remote triggers.
- Execute the initial drop test, record descent speed and full closure, then reset and secure the label per NFPA 80 procedures.

Those five steps bring a lot of craft inside them. On old CMU, you could find spaces in the block behind the overview supports. A tech with experience will change to the appropriate anchors, adjust the embedment, and verify pull-out strength, instead of thoughtlessly hammering wedge anchors into a dental caries. When the slab inclines toward a dock drainpipe, the sill might require a built-up limit so the lower bar seals uniformly. 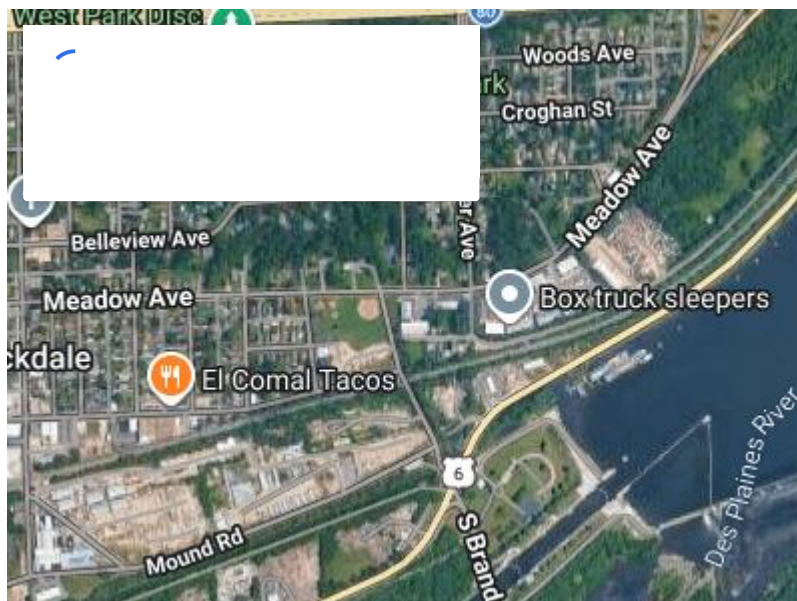
