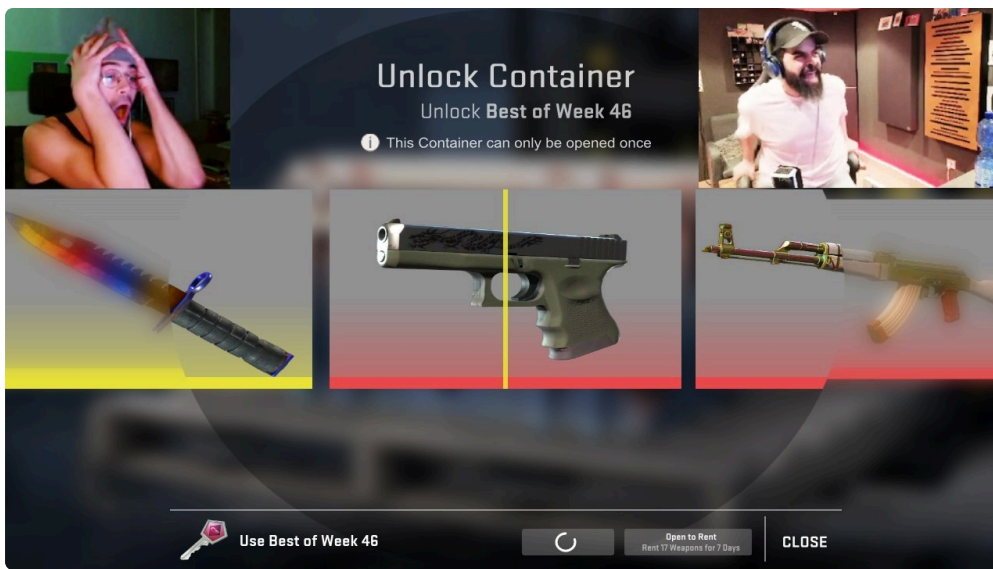
Rates are derived from the Steam Community Market and trusted third-party markets as of early 2025. They fluctuate in response to case appeal, operation cycles, and overall demand.
