

The Ins and Outs of Knife Opening in CS: GO

Note: The precise probability for a specific knife (e.g., Karambit|Fade) is a fraction of the unusual special item pool.

These numbers highlight that the overwhelming bulk of openings will produce basic skins, not knives. The low probability makes knife openings a high-risk, high-reward activity.

Popular Knife Types and Market Values

Knife skins are categorized by their rarity and visual appeal. Below is a table summarizing a few of the most sought-after knives and their typical market value varieties (as of early 2026):

Tips for Responsible Knife Opening

- Set a Budget**-- Decide beforehand just how much you are prepared to spend. Deal with the cash as home entertainment cost, not an investment.
- Comprehend the Odds**-- Recognize that the large majority of openings will not yield a knife. The expected return is unfavorable.
- Avoid Chasing Losses**-- If a gamer spends a predetermined budget plan without obtaining a knife, it is recommended to stop instead of effort to "recover" losses.
- Consider Trading**-- Once a knife is obtained, players can hold onto it expecting future cost appreciation or trade it immediately for other products or cash.
