2. **Pattern/StatTrak™**-- StatTrak™ skins (those that track kills) are normally scarcer than their vanilla counterparts.
3. **Case or Collection Age**-- Skins from ceased cases (e.g., *The Arms Deal Case*) become increasingly limited as the case stops dropping.
4. **Event or Esports Origin**-- Limited-time tournament Souvenirs or items tied to particular majors (e.g., *Cobblestone Keepsake*) rarely reappear.
5. **Distinct Finishes**-- Special finishes such as *Fade*, *Case Hardened* (with a high blue gem pattern), or *Night Stripe* have an unique visual appeal that fuels need.
