We establish stands, vacuumed the store two times, wore lint-loose sleeves, and filtered the paint. After an adhesion primer, we applied a top build tooth, then wet sanded between coats with 600 grit. The ultimate coat went on with an HVLP gun at low tension. The result reflected sunlight like a replicate. It took longer than the consumer estimated, however the doorways nonetheless draw compliments, and so they blank with a humid microfiber with out haze.
