4. Kinds Of Case Battle Giveaways

- **Arranged Giveaways**-- Occur at a set time every day (e.g., 8 PM UTC). Players should register before the start.
- **Instant Giveaways**-- Randomly activated after any case battle concludes; winners are drawn immediately from the pool of individuals.
