Key Rules to Look for in Live Casinos

Not all live blackjack tables are developed equal. Before joining a virtual seat, gamers should thoroughly take a look at the specific guidelines of the table, as they straight impact the home edge.

- **Blackjack Payouts:** Always search for tables that pay **3:2** for a natural blackjack. Avoid tables that pay **6:5**, as this significantly increases your home advantage.
- **Dealer Soft 17 Rule:** Check whether the dealer needs to hit or base on a soft 17 (an Ace and a 6). A dealership standing on soft 17 is more beneficial to the player.

- **Double Down Restrictions:** Some tables restrict doubling down to hard overalls of 10 and 11 only, while others enable doubling on any 2 cards. The latter is always much better for the player.
- **Dividing Rules:** Look for tables that permit gamers to divide pair to three or 4 times (resulting in numerous hands) and those that permit doubling down after splitting (DAS).
- **Surrender Option:** Late surrender enables a gamer to surrender half their bet if they dislike their initial two-card hand against the dealership's strong upcard. While uncommon, it is a valuable guideline for decreasing losses.
