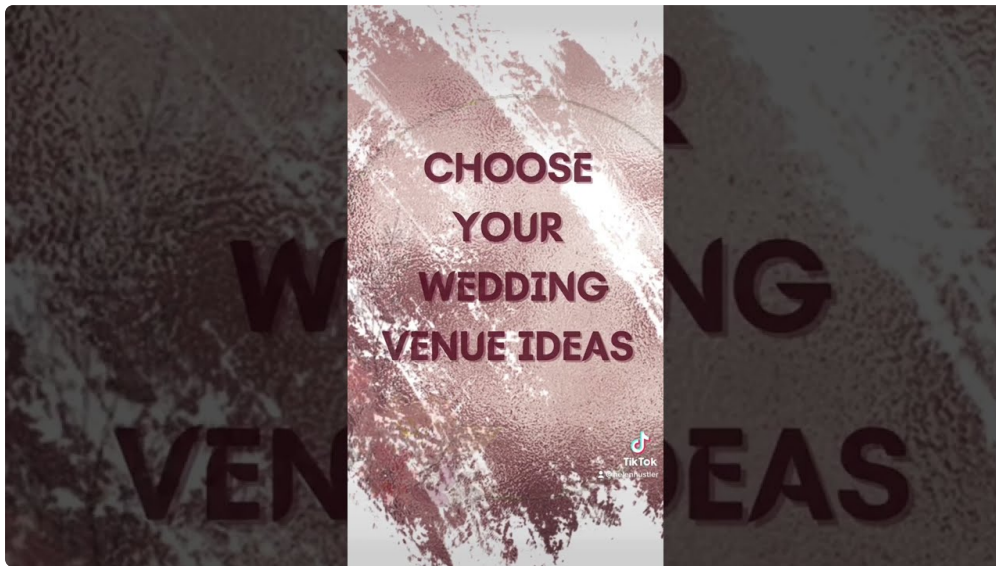


Orchestrating a Secret Celebration Without Any the Guest of Honor Knowing

The Deception

A crucial component of a properly organized unexpected gathering is the plausible explanation you'll give the guest of honor for any required activities before the surprise.

The explanation ought to be straightforward enough to maintain however specific enough to be convincing and one the birthday person won't question.

Managing the Details
