On white marbles, I characteristically combo a hot tint with a bit of gray to healthy the body, then feather darker near a vein. I use a two-phase structural adhesive designed for stone, no longer popular epoxy from the hardware keep. Working time varies with temperature. On stones with shaded flow, I might rotate the items ever so a little bit to align a vein. Scraping the squeeze-out is set timing. Early, the adhesive smears. Late, it chips. I stay a plastic razor or a sharpened hardwood stick for the first cross, then a single-aspect razor held close to flat to shave the line refreshing because it gels. I minimize the miter at a true 45 with a tiny lower back bevel, do a dry run with seam setters located vertically, and use a slower-curing adhesive for an extended operating time. Finishes: polish, honed, and leathered, and what they do to seams

Keep it cool to keep away from resin burn.

Color mismatch requires staying power, no longer more tint thrown on the joint after the truth. I even have repulled seams day after today if the healing colour drifted.
