

Same-Day Garage Door Repair Near Me in Los Angeles

Failed Springs, Cables, and Rollers

A broken garage door spring is one of the most urgent repair issues. Springs balance the weight of the door, allowing the opener or a person to lift it safely. A **torsion spring** is mounted above the door and rotates as the door moves. An **extension spring** stretches alongside the horizontal tracks. Both types are under significant tension.

Signs of spring failure include a visible separation in the coil, a door that feels unusually heavy, a loose cable, or an opener that runs without lifting the door. Garage door cables can fray, slip from their drums, or break when springs fail. Worn garage door rollers may also create vibration, resistance, and scraping noises.

If you search for “garage door spring replacement near me,” do not attempt to remove or adjust the spring yourself. A professional can select the replacement to the door’s weight, dimensions, and operating

requirements. Replacing only one related component may not solve the problem if the cables, drums, bearings, or rollers are also worn.
